**Outdoor Worship will begin at 10:30 a.m. at the courtsquare.** "All Creatures Great and Small" will be the theme for worship next Sunday, June 25 at the courtsquare with congregations from Upper Room Assembly and Worship Center, The Salvation Army and The Presbyterian Church. Three messages by the host pastors will celebrate animals of God's creation – Fish of the sea (Captain Tom Clark); Shepherd Dogs (Pastor Stan Braxton) and Birds of the air (Rev. Jonathan Carlisle) with scripture stories about those animals.

The "Blessing of the Animals" will be done at the end of worship with folks invited to bring small animals to be blessed. The blessing of each animal, by name, means that health, healing and life are being mediated from God for the benefit of the animal in its relationship with its human partners. We are all beneficiaries of God's love and care. In the Genesis story, all animals, including people, are living peacefully in God's presence. This tradition of blessing the animals dates back to Francis of Assisi.



There will be three offering baskets available - one for each congregation. Loose offerings will go to the Community Food Pantry of The Salvation Army. Music will be provided by the Upper Room worship team and a brass group from The Salvation Army. Nursery care will be available. Upper Room (former Civic Hall, 331 Main St.) will be the rain location. Join us for an interesting time of worship and blessing!
